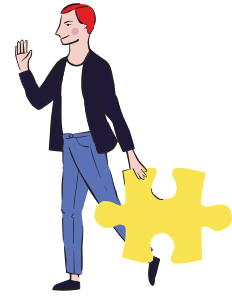




The job search obligation can be met by



1. Applying for a job lasting at least two weeks in an employment relationship for which the job seeker could arguably expect to be hired

- applying for vacant positions
- submitting an open job application
- direct contacts with employers.

2. Applying for jobs offered to you by the employment services.

- employment may last less than two weeks.

3. Applying for more work from one's own employer.

4. Seeking entrepreneurial work opportunities by which the job seeker could arguably expect to be employed.

- advertising of personal enterprise
- contacts with possible commissioners of work
- participation in bidding competitions.

5. Publishing a presentation at 'Työmarkkinatori' web portal.

6. Other actions with the goal of finding employment, such as

- registering into the employee register of a company renting out labour
- seeking grants for work purposes
- publishing a portfolio online
- publishing a LinkedIn profile
- concrete actions linked with starting a business.
